Code of Ethics:

1. THE TEACHER’S ATTITUDE TOWARDS THE PROFESSION:
 - a. To uphold a high standard of artistic value in music.
 - b. To strive to promote music as an art, rather than merely as a trade or manual skill.
 - c. To Help maintain the dignity of the profession.
 - d. To represent teaching qualifications truthfully and without exaggeration..
 - e. To seek continually to improve teaching skill through study, research, participation in discussions, workshops and listening to music.
2. THE TEACHER’S ATTITUDE TOWARD THE STUDENT:
 - a. To develop the student’s love, enthusiasm and respect for music.
 - b. To discourage in the student any illusory hopes or unfounded ambitions.
 - c. To set an example in personal conduct which may be of benefit to the student.
3. THE TEACHER’S ATTITUDE TOWARD COLLEAGUES:
 - a. To respect the work of other teachers.
 - b. To endorse as pupils only those students who have had at least six months of study with the present teachers.
 - c. To avoid making disparaging remarks about other teachers and their work.
 - d. To avoid presenting material in publi which the student has learned with a different teacher.
